

PRIMARY DIFFERENCES BETWEEN CKC RALLY AND CARO / APDT

- Only CKC registered / recognized breeds may compete
- Minimum score of 70 out of a possible 100 to qualify
- Fewer stations per level
- Disabled dogs may not compete; disabled handlers may compete
- No maximum time requirements to complete course
- Food is not permitted
- Petting (i.e. touching dog is permitted)
- Minimum ring is smaller (40 x 50) but 40 x 80 is recommended
- Jump height vs dog height is different - See Chart handout
- Some exercise names are slightly different - See Chart handout
- Send Over Jump Handler Runs By exercise - CKC rules do not specify how far away from the side of the jump the handler must run
- All 3 CKC jumps are available for use - 1 jump is to be used at the Advanced level and 2 are to be used at the Excellent level
- Halt-Turn Right, One Step - CKC dog is called to heel position after handler makes turn, APDT and CARO - dog moves with handler.
- Collars - Only collars allowed in CKC obed ring are to be used in RallyO. Harnesses are permitted in CARO and APDT - slip chain collars are not.
- "Luring" with an "air cookie" is allowed under CKC Rally rules - it is not allowed in APDT or CARO
- Timing - CKC & CARO - rounds are timed and are used to break ties - fastest time wins. APDT - only run off is timed for fastest time. Timing the rounds is to ensure team does not go over allotted time for the particular level.
